D. Support Marketing & Advertising (If Enabled)

Tools like Facebook Pixel or Google Ads may track:

- Page views
- Form submissions
- Visitor behavior

This allows us to understand which ads or posts bring families to our site.

3. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

Essential Cookies: Required for the website to function.

These cannot be disabled.

Performance & Analytics Cookies: Used to analyze traffic and improve site performance.

Functional Cookies: Remember user preferences and enhance usability.

Advertising & Tracking Cookies (If Enabled): Used for remarketing, ad performance, and audience insights.

4. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

We may use third-party services such as:

- Google Analytics
- Facebook Pixel
- WordPress/Elementor tools
- Cookie consent plugins

These providers may set their own cookies.
We do not control third-party cookie settings.

5. HOW TO MANAGE OR DISABLE COOKIES

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings.

Most browsers allow you to:

- Block cookies
- Delete cookies
- Receive alerts before cookies are stored

Please note:

Disabling cookies may affect website functionality.

6. “DO NOT TRACK” (DNT) SIGNALS
